Program Information:

The APPLE program is administered by the California Student Aid Commission.

For agreeing to teach in a low performing or low income school, or a designated shortage area

(i.e. Math Science) once you obtain your credential, the APPLE Grant will repay **\$11,000** in student

loans. For Math/Science majors, **\$15,000 to \$19,000** in student loans may be paid.

Eligibility:

- Pass Teacher Credential Program interview
 - o Includes:
 - 2.5 minimum GPA
 - Essay
 - Faculty recommendation
- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Have completed a minimum of 60 semester or 90 quarter units prior to the term of application
- Enroll in the Teacher Credential Program at SDCC
- Remain enrolled each term at least half time in coursework for the credential or B.A.
- Have a student loan in good standing
- Not have completed coursework toward a credential
